Needles and syringes are considered biohazardous waste and must be disposed of properly. A sharps container will be ordered along with your medications for you to safely dispose of your needles and syringes. This sharps container must be taken to an accepting disposal site once full.

**We cannot accept or dispose of your full sharps containers.**
